



# USEFUL INFORMATION

As you prepare to attend ACCES this year, we recommend that you read the following information.

## VISA

Make sure to check if a visa is required for you to enter Tanzania. For more information, visit the ACCES website: [www.musicinafrica.net/aces/info](http://www.musicinafrica.net/aces/info)

**Visa letter:** A visa letter is automatically sent to you with the confirmation email for ACCES registration. Make sure to check your SPAM folder if you don't see it. **For referral visa support documents, [click here](#).**

## SAFETY

Take sensible precautions. Just like in any other city, avoid carrying large sums of money or valuables. Use a hotel safe whenever possible and be particularly vigilant when withdrawing cash from ATMs. In general, avoid travelling alone, especially at night.

## TRANSPORT

**Airport shuttle:** Unless otherwise communicated to you in writing, the ACCES airport shuttle is only reserved for speakers and artists. Most hotels in Tanzania provide an airport shuttle. Do make necessary arrangements with your hotel.

**Travel in Dar es Salaam:** We recommend Uber and Bolt as they are reliable and offer standard prices.

## INTERNET

Internet is generally fast in Tanzania but you may experience low speeds at hotels and other public spaces. We recommend that you get a local sim card (at the airport or in most stores around Dar es Salaam).

## REGISTRATION PIN CODE

Keep the pin code which you have received upon registering private and safe. You will need it.

## MONEY

Tanzania uses Tanzanian shilling (TSh). One dollar (\$US1) is equivalent to about 2 332,00 TSh. You can buy local currency at the airport and in most banks. Also, ATMs are almost everywhere in Dar es Salaam.

## IDENTIFICATION

We recommend that you keep your passport in a safe place. Do carry a copy of your ID, however, as authorities may ask for it.

## WEATHER

The average temperature in Dar es Salaam in November for a typical day ranges from a high of 86°F (30°C) and a low of 78°F (25°C). Some would describe it as pleasantly warm with a gentle breeze. For comparison, the hottest month in Dar es Salaam, February, has days with highs of 87°F (30°C) and lows of 79°F (26°C).

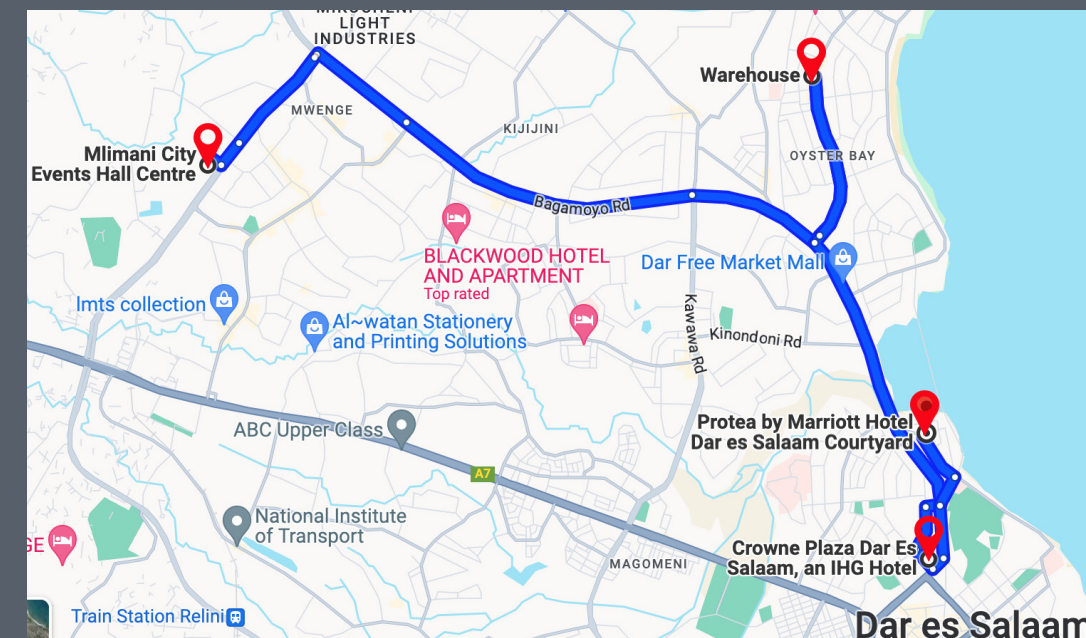
